Day 2 - SKY - WEEK 1

MEMORY VERSE – "I am the one who made the earth and created people to live on it. With my hands I stretched out the heavens. All the stars are at my command." Isaiah 45:12

FOCUS VERSE – "Then God said, 'Let there be a space between the waters, to separate the waters of the heavens from the waters of the earth.' And that is what happened. God made this space to separate the waters of the earth from the waters of the heavens. God called the space, 'sky.' And evening passed and morning came, marking the second day." Genesis 1:6–8

STORY – What type of things do we find in the sky? Let them answer: birds, clouds, rainbows, airplanes, etc. On Day 2 God created the sky, and He called it good! Our memory verse reminds that God says, "with My hands I stretched out the heavens."

Can we see the WHOLE sky? All around the world? No! Everytime we look up at the sky we can be reminded of His love for us! Just like the sky, God's love is so big that we can't see or understand how much God loves us!

There's a story in the bible where God fills the sky with clouds and made it rain for 40 days and nights! God's faithful servant, Noah built an ark, which is another name for a really big boat! God said to get two of every animal and put them on the boat. Noah obeyed God and so his family was able to go on the boat too. The rain came and the animals and Noah's family were safe! After the rain stopped God promised to never send a flood like that again and showed that by putting a rainbow in the sky. So everytime you see a rainbow in the sky, you can remember this story about how God keeps His promises and how His love is always there for us!

PRAYER – Lord, thank you that every time we look up at the sky we are reminded of how much you love us and how you keep your promises!

SNACK - Blue jello cups with whip cream and/or marshmallows as clouds

CRAFT - Glue small pieces of colored cardstock in rainbow order on the rainbow coloring sheet. Older kids can cut the small pieces, younger can just glue.

GAME – Rainbow mix up game. Give seven friends different colored "crowns" have them close their eyes to get mixed up. They have to work together to get themselves back in "rainbow color" order! (Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple).
