INTRODUCTION - WEEK 1

MEMORY VERSE – “I am the one who made the earth and created people to live on it. With my hands I stretched out the heavens. All the stars are at my command.” Isaiah 45:12

FOCUS VERSE – “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.” Genesis 1:1-2

STORY – Have you heard about God creating the world? Did you know that He created EVERYTHING? *What are some things that God created?* In the beginning of the Bible in the book of Genesis, *can you say Genesis with me?*, it tells us when God created all the amazing things on the Earth. As I say each day, show me the numbers with your fingers!

Day 1 - Light

Day 2 - Sky

Day 3 - Land, sea, trees, and plants

Day 4 - Sun, moon and stars

Day 5 - Fish and birds

Day 6 - Animals and us!

Day 7 - He rested

After God created each day He called each part of His creation, GOOD. *What does GOOD mean?*

Let's make up a song or rhyme with hand motions to help us remember the good things God created each day. Each Sunday we will be learning about the good things God created! It's going to be an exciting adventure!

PRAYER – Lord, thank you that the Bible tells us about how You created everything! We are excited to learn more about how good You are!

SNACK – Goldfish

CRAFT – Talk about how we “create” every time we do a craft or color.
