U – UNDERSTANDING

MEMORY VERSE – “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.” Hebrews 13:8

FOCUS VERSE – “But Jesus said, “Let the children come to me. Don’t stop them! For the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to those who are like these children.” Matthew 19:14

STORY – Let’s spell Jesus’ name together! *J.E.S.U.S!* This week we are learning about the U, *say U with me*, in Jesus’ name. The U is for UNDERSTANDING.

What does being understanding mean? Jesus understands us because He is the one who made us! He understands our questions, our emotions and how we think!
